

HOUSE TO HOUSE COLLECTIONS ACT 1939

ORDER OF EXEMPTION

WHEREAS, Donald Wellesley McFarlane, chair of Adventist Development and Relief Agency board (ADRA-UK), Stanborough Park, Watford, Hertfordshire WD25 9JZ has satisfied the Minister for the Cabinet Office that in that capacity he pursues a charitable purpose throughout a substantial part of England and Wales and is desirous of promoting collections for that purpose.

NOW THEREFORE in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the House to House Collections Act 1939, the Minister for the Cabinet Office hereby directs that the said, Donald Wellesley McFarlane shall, in the said capacity, be exempt from the provisions of subsection (2) of section 1 of the said Act, as respects all collections promoted by him in any part of England and Wales in aid of Adventist Development and Relief Agency UK (ADRA-UK).

FURTHERMORE permission is hereby granted for the promotion of envelope collections in accordance with regulation 13(1) of the House to House Collections Regulations 1947.

Unless this Order is revoked beforehand **THIS EXEMPTION** shall expire when the repeal of the House to House Collections Act 1939 by Schedule 7 to the Charities Act 1992 is brought into force.

AND the Minister for the Cabinet Office hereby revokes the previous Order of Exemption granted on 3 May 2001 to Cecil Roy Perry formerly Chief Promoter of Adventist Relief Agency UK (ADRA-UK).
